Summary of the Event:

Many modern parents begin to worry if their child is slow at learning. To start with, parents and teachers need to refrain from negative comments such as labeling the child as ‘dumb’, ‘loser’, or any such absurd monikers. Children are super-sensitive and they depend on feedbacks from grownups to set their little lives in order. Your negativity further affects the child’s learning process as he begins to believe in his inability to learn.

Slow learner: Slow learners are children taking a little more time than others do to grasp a concept. A child who takes more time and focus to think than others his age is said to be a slow learner. This child will hit the basic developmental stages just like his peers, but at a significantly slower rate. Nevertheless, this development will be relatively even.

To identify the slow learner in the group of students is an important task before to think how to deal with them.

To explore the various methods to identify and deal with the slow learner CHAMOS Matrusanstha Department of Mechanical Engineering has organized a Poster presentation event under the aegis of Equal Opportunity Cell on “ **How to improve learning capabilities in slow learner**” for the teaching faculties of CHARUSAT. Symptoms in Slow Learner:

Slow reaction time, Lack of confidence, poor memory, and inability to express ideas, local point of view, less concentration, consistently getting poor grade in tests, lack of interest, unable to communicate, avoiding eye contact, lose track of time.

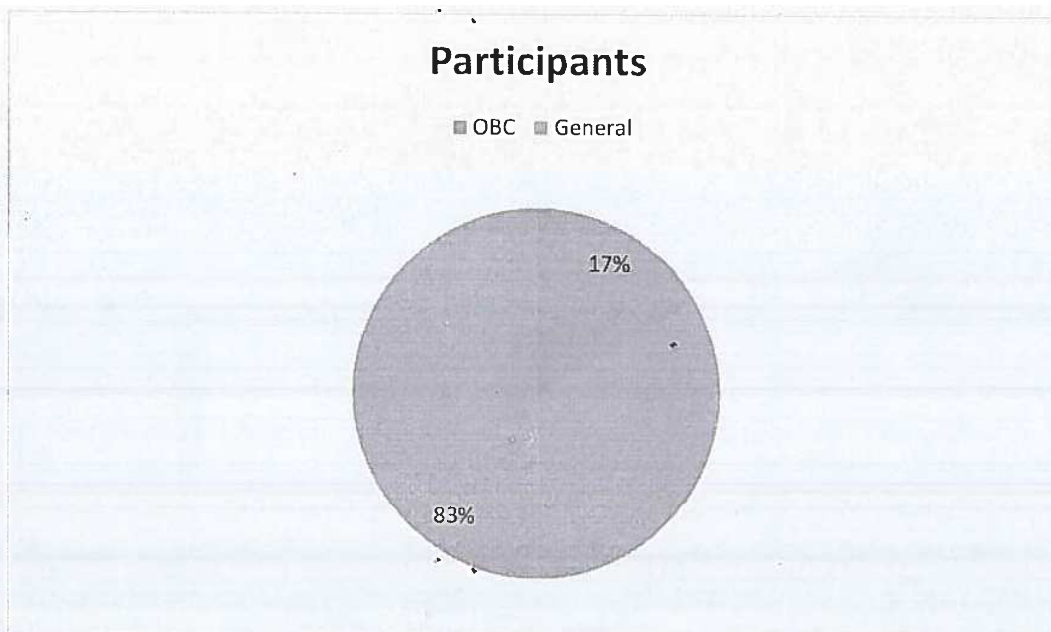
How to deal with Slow Learner to improve their learning capabilities:

Personal attention, development of self-confidence, flexibility in curriculum, treat with empathy, Audio visual aids, create free environment to learn without fear, guidance from peers, change seating, reduce distraction, assign small task, one to one interaction, restructure expectations, arrange remedial classes, give time to react on the task, use more images instead words, teach with real life examples to increase curiosity, teach with appropriated games, encourage for small achievement also, give chance to everyone to answer, meditation, continuous feedback, spend sufficient time with them, group discussion, give sufficient break time while teaching, initially use their familiar language for teaching, focus on oral communication first instead written communication, allow to express his view without any threatening, create healthy

relations with students and friendly learning class atmosphere, sometime use ice-breaker, have fun with some interval time of teaching, reward the students.

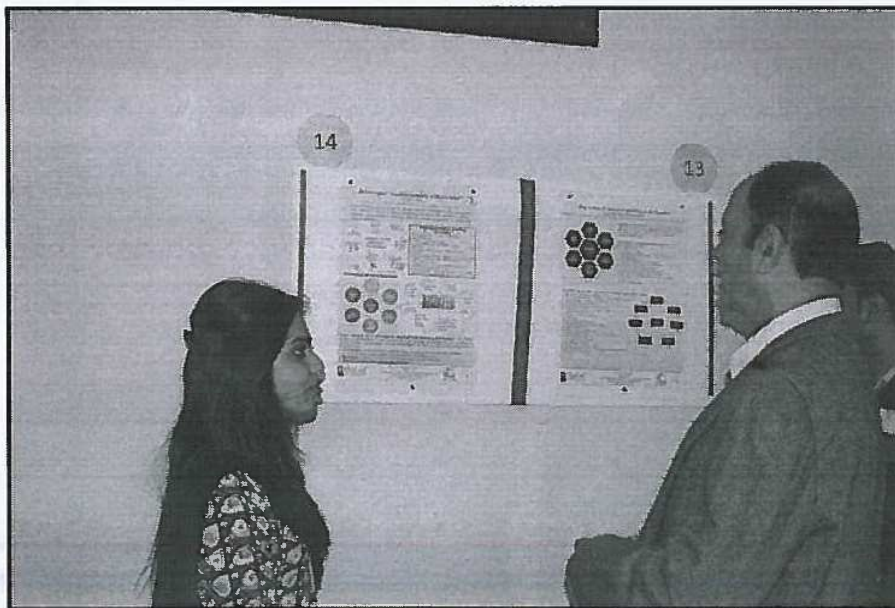

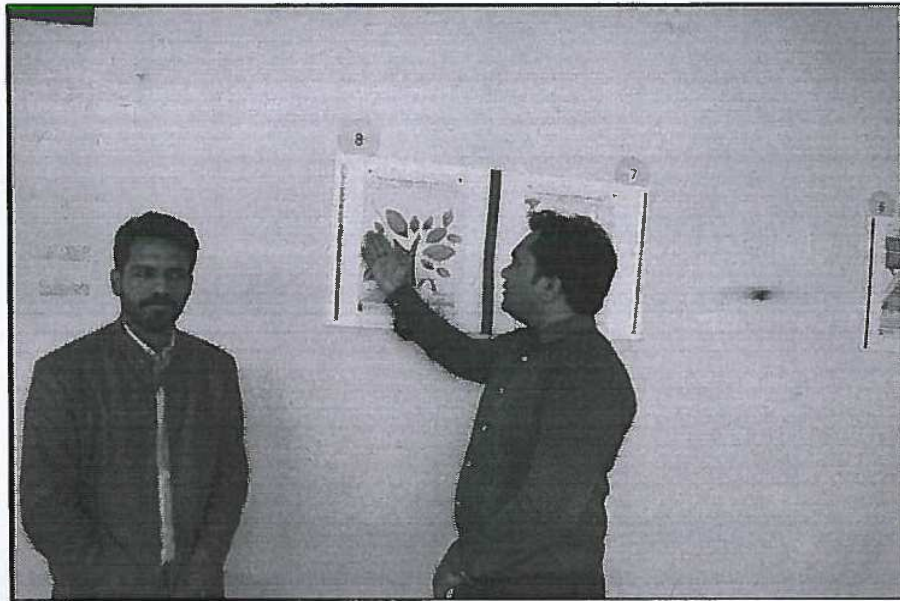

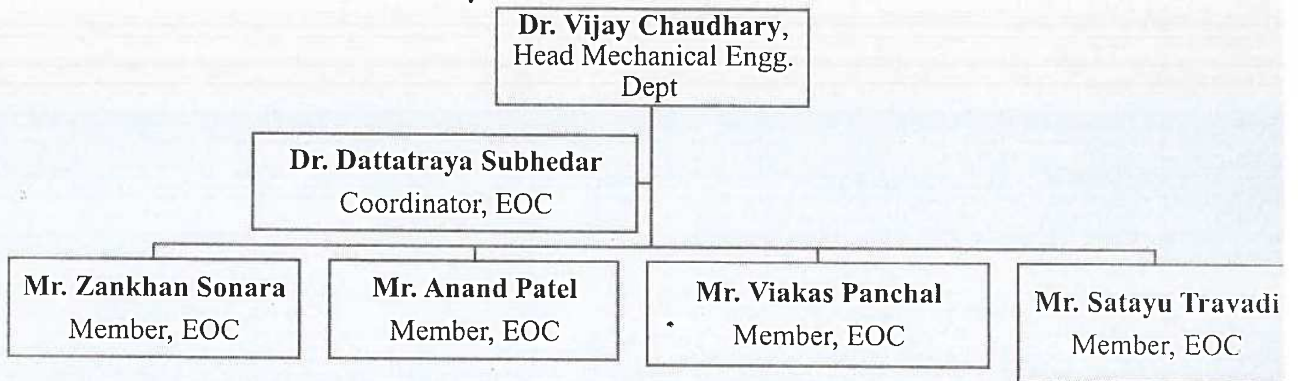

Introduction:

Women Entrepreneurship Development Programme (WEDP) under the Department of Science & Technology scheme aims to train the S&T graduates and diploma holders in the entrepreneurship essentials - conceive, plan, initiate, launch and maintain economic activity or run a successful enterprise. Majority of the women face problems while dealing with the management of business and its other aspects like managing clients, **communications**, funding opportunities, credit applications, marketing of the business (products/services) etc. Access to better advisory and training would help women that are behind the small-scale family-owned businesses and others who are willing to start their own business.

This free training programme will be conducted with the help of well-trained experts. In this programme, women trainees will identify right business idea for them, steps to follow, and develop necessary knowledge and skills to evaluate and run a business.

Women entrepreneurs in Ethiopia are disadvantaged from the start. They have less access to the finance, networks, and education which help their male counterparts advance. They face regular discrimination and harassment from society—sometimes even from their own families and communities. The challenges a woman entrepreneur in Ethiopia faces in growing her business are overwhelming.

Only one-third of the small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs) in the world are run by women. Women-business owners in developing countries face significant challenges to run their businesses, particularly in accessing finance.

Programme objectives:

- WEDP aims at providing budding women entrepreneurs with skills, adding support through growth-oriented business incubator and business accelerator.
- Understand the process of women empowerment through entrepreneurship development.
- Create an awareness of the need and importance of entrepreneurship.
- Develop vision, strategy & structure for entrepreneurship development.

- Evaluate new venture opportunity.
- Make them aware about promotional financial & regulating scheme for women.
- Develop skills in mobilizing and organizing women in recognition of women's potential as agents for social change.
- Prepare feasible & viable project.
- Develop necessary skills of enterprise creation and small business management.
