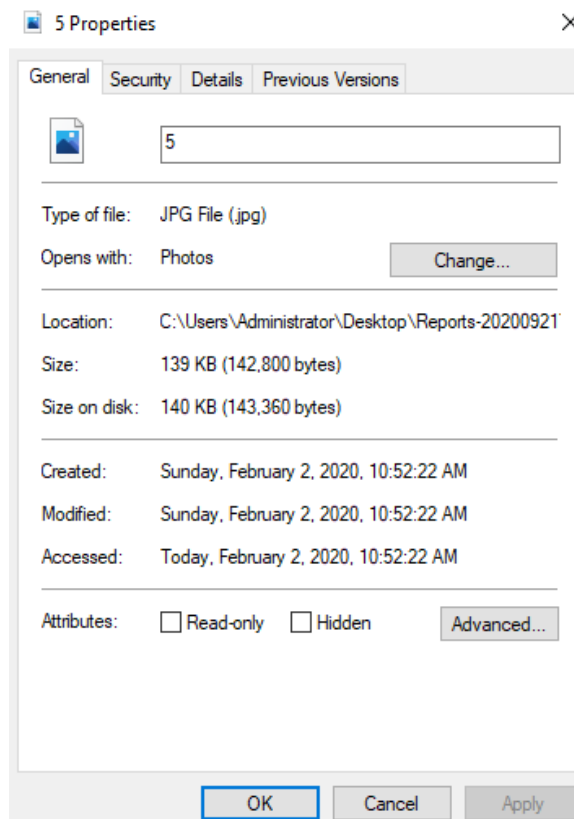

***A Report on Bridge Course for English Language and Communication (BBA 1)***

English is the dominant professional and business language and wide range of technological literature is available in it. So it is necessary to provide the support to the large number of management students who are coming with vernacular language. Students are guided for reading, listening speaking and writing skills. This year institute started Poster Presentation from the BBA Semester 1 students. During the Bridge Course, the learning they received and the problems they faced, students are instructed to prepare a poster for the same. A poster presentation is a way to communicate students understanding of a topic in a short and concise format. It usually includes two elements - a poster and a brief (usually no more than 2 minutes) explanation.

Poster presentations develop ability of student to communicate perceptively (matching their explanation to the audience) and concisely - an important workplace skill. They may be used to present quite complex material, and so it is important. Following questions were discussed:

- What is the purpose of your Poster
- Who will be looking at your Poster
- What will your audience are looking for Poster
- Where will your poster be?

Furthermore, students are expected to gain the following proficiency:

- Write simple sentences in English on the poster
- Use basic grammatical structures in the poster
- Converse in simple sentences in class room through poster
- To develop confidence in communicating oneself spontaneously
- To develop confidence in interacting with the teacher and peer

Women entrepreneurs in Ethiopia are disadvantaged from the start. They have less access to the finance, networks, and education which help their male counterparts advance. They face regular discrimination and harassment from society—sometimes even from their own families and communities. The challenges a woman entrepreneur in Ethiopia faces in growing her business are overwhelming.

Only one-third of the small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs) in the world are run by women. Women-business owners in developing countries face significant challenges to run their businesses, particularly in accessing finance.

### Programme objectives:

- WEDP aims at providing budding women entrepreneurs with skills, adding support through growth-oriented business incubator and business accelerator.
- Understand the process of women empowerment through entrepreneurship development.
- Create an awareness of the need and importance of entrepreneurship.
- Develop vision, strategy & structure for entrepreneurship development.

- Evaluate new venture opportunity.
- Make them aware about promotional financial & regulating scheme for women.
- Develop skills in mobilizing and organizing women in recognition of women's potential as agents for social change.
- Prepare feasible & viable project.
- Develop necessary skills of enterprise creation and small business management.

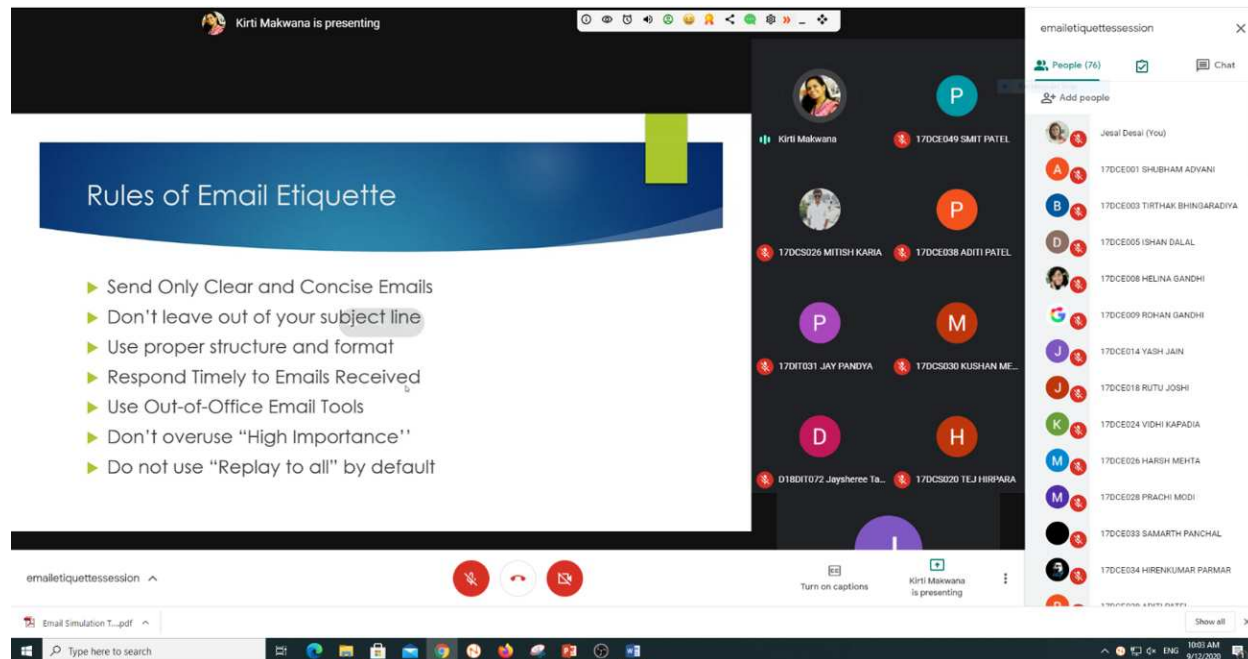

A good resume will immediately display to employers why the candidate is a good fit. A session is arranged to guide students about building powerful resumes.

About the session: A resume is an important tool for your job search because it offers a page or two where you can display your top skills and qualities. However, a resume is much more than that. Resumes help employers make hiring decisions and help you get your first interview. That is why it matters how you structure your resume and what information you decide to include. In this article, you will learn why a resume is important and get actionable resume tips that may help you achieve your next career move.

Why do you need a resume?

Here are some reasons why you need a resume to get your next job:

- A resume outlines your relevant skills and experience
- Displays the benefits you offer employers
- Grabs the attention of employers
- Matches you to the position
- Can lead to an interview

*A resume outlines your relevant skills and experience*

A well-structured resume clearly highlights your most attractive skills and experience to potential employers. This allows them to move forward with the best candidate. It's important to make sure your most recent skills and experiences are reflected in your resume for this reason. A strong resume

uses formatting elements like color, appropriate margins and design to ensure relevant work experience is shown in such a way that highlights achievements.

*Displays the benefits you offer employers*

More importantly, a resume shouldn't just offer skills and experience, it should tell employers what you bring to the company. For example, if you're leaving a sales position, instead of just saying that you are a "high performer," say you "achieved \$250,000 of new media sales in one year". This allows employers to understand the value you bring to the company in terms that are quantifiable.

If you can use three or four achievements under each piece of relevant experience that offer verifiable metrics. Consider things like increasing profit or reducing loss by 5%, growing a social media following by 1,500 users or increasing sales by 10%.

*Grabs the attention of employers*

The part of the resume known as "above the fold"—usually the top quarter of the resume—is considered the most attention grabbing. Make sure to include important summarized information above the fold in addition to your name and contact information. Another way you can get an employer's attention is to use a layout that allows for appropriate color or images.

Some people will use a headshot portrait or personal logo to brand themselves to employers. If you have to print your resume, always make sure to use a resume paper stock that sticks out. There are a lot of options to choose from, so pay attention to industry standards when deciding on paper.

- 5) Publish in an acceptable form

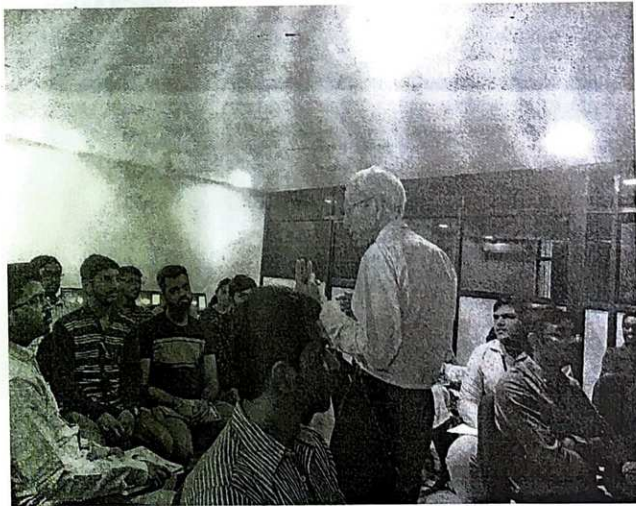
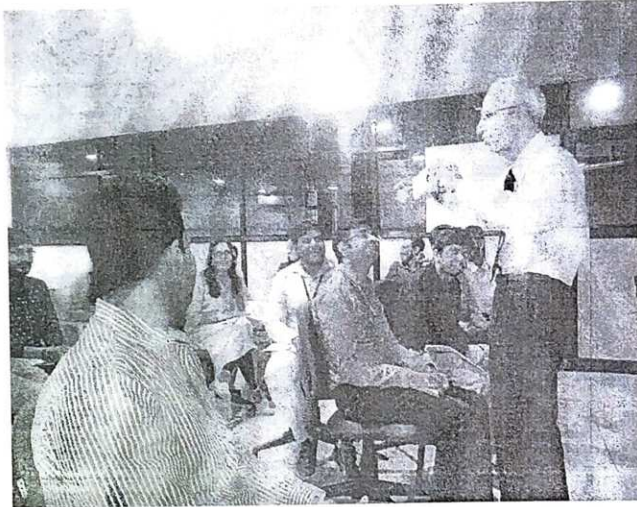
