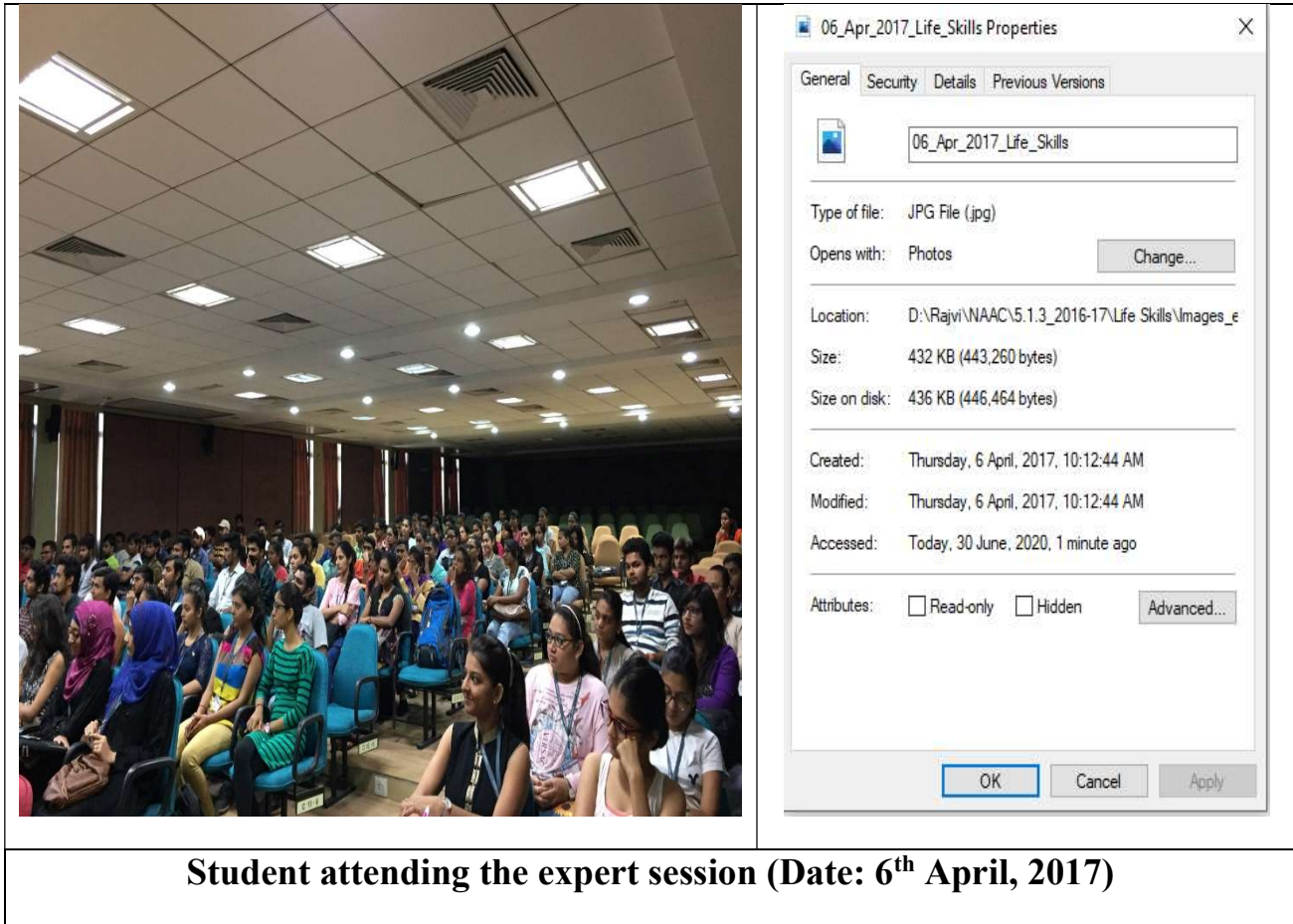

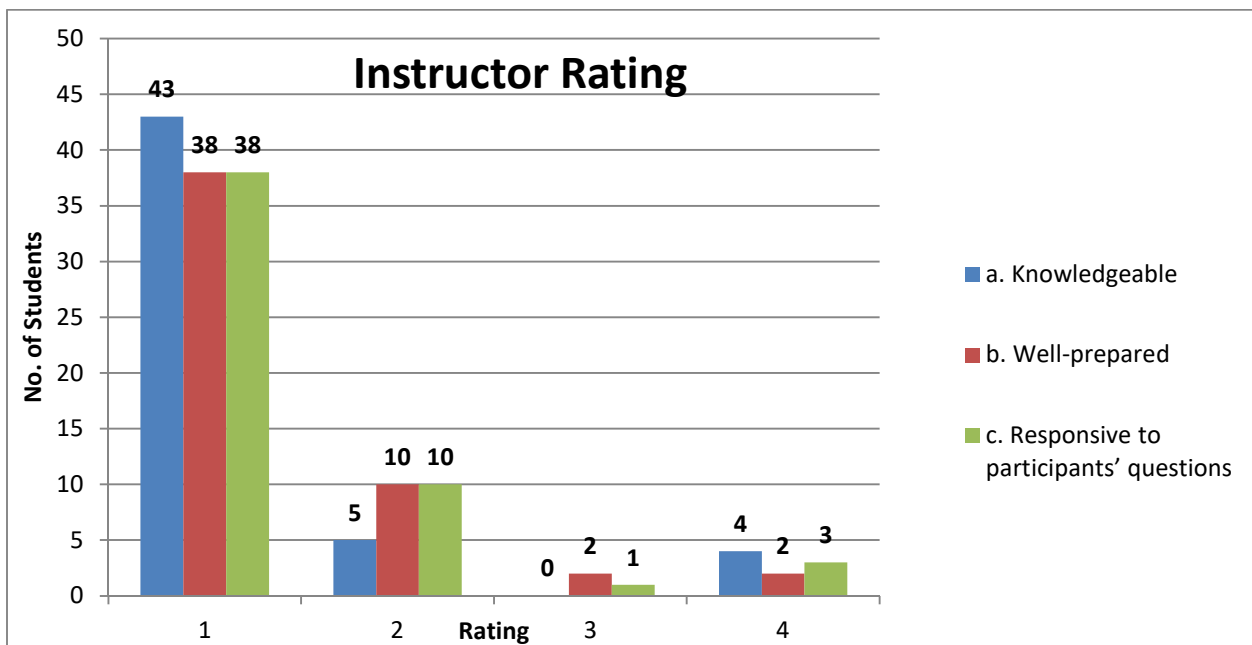
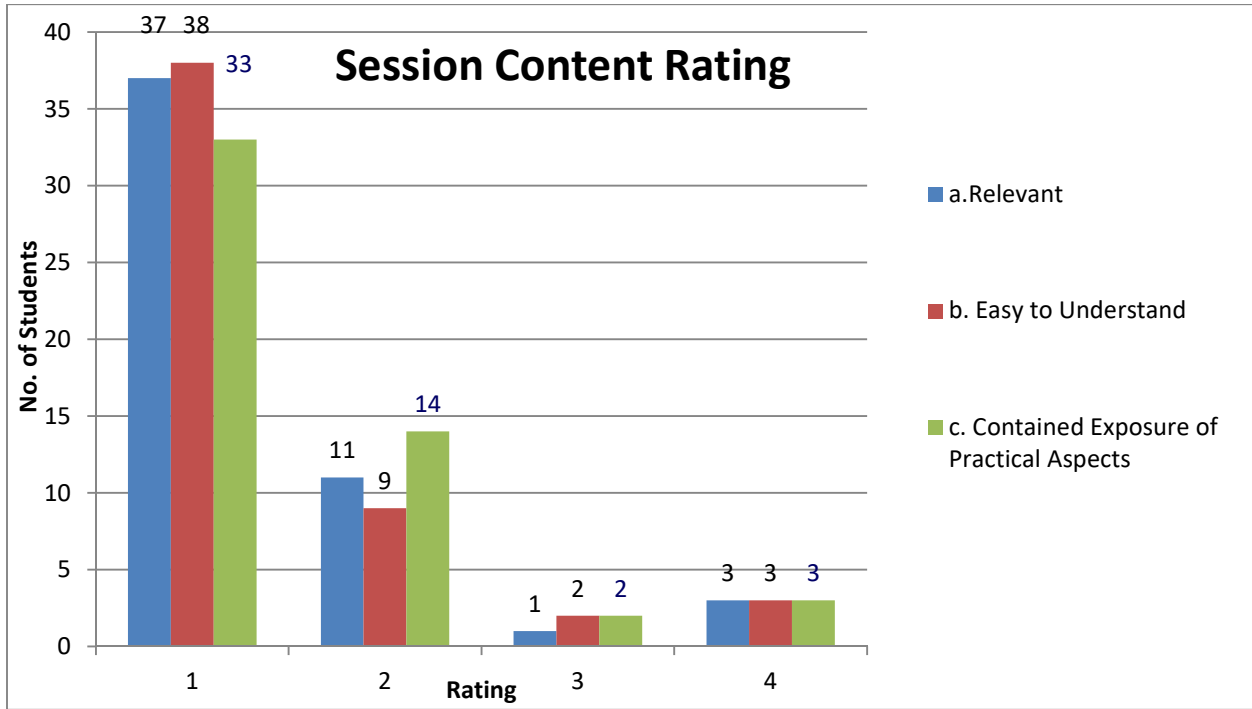

Report of Exhibition on Environmental Sanitation

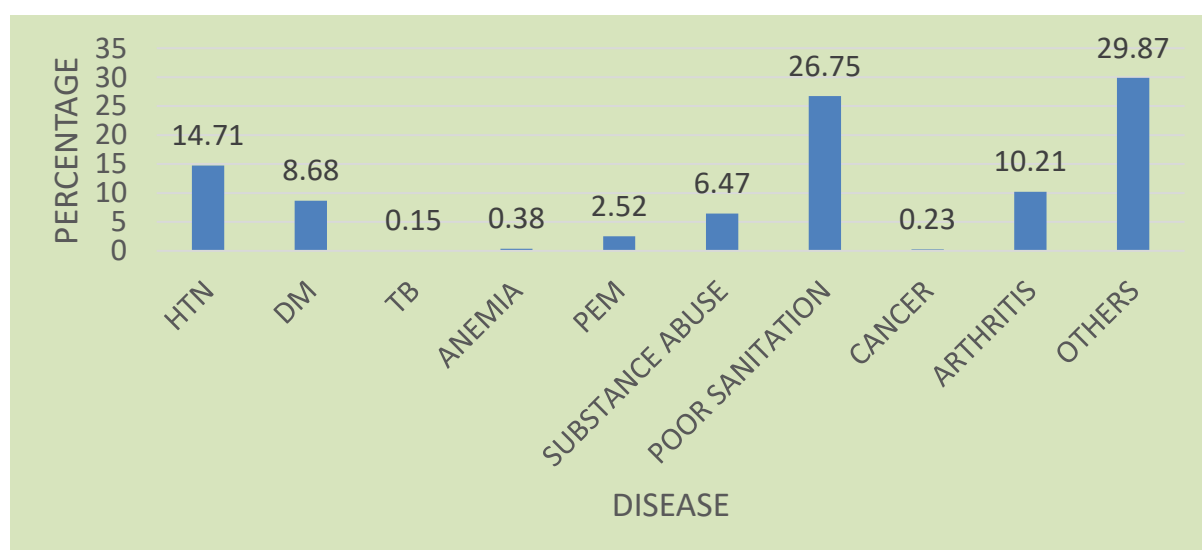
Introduction:

Community Diagnosis:

Community Diagnosis shows that 26.75% of people were having poor sanitation. 14.71% people were suffering with hypertension and least 0.15% cases were TB.

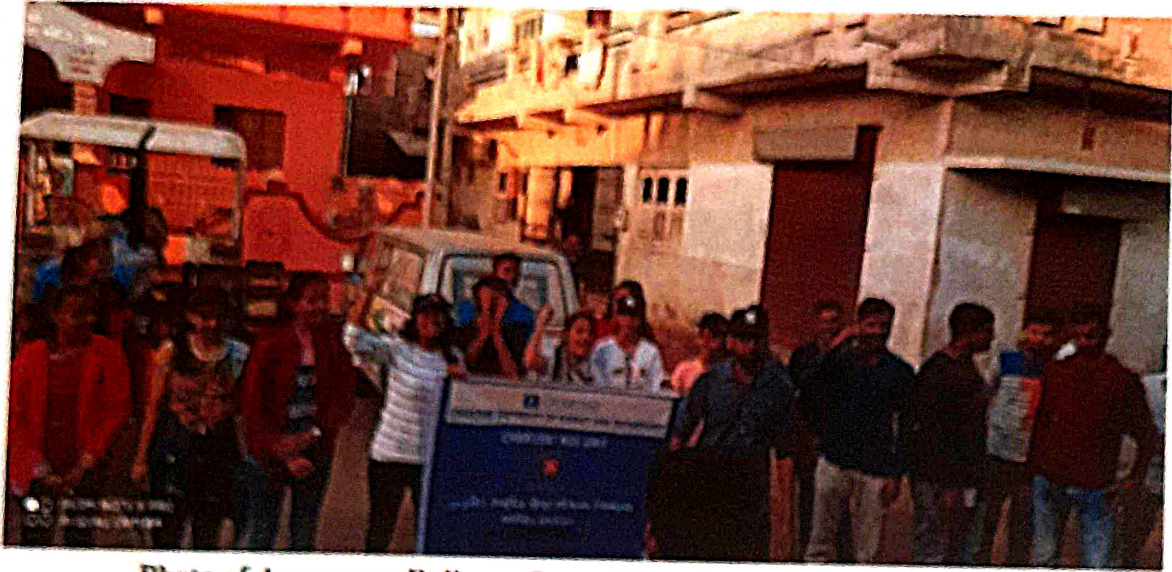

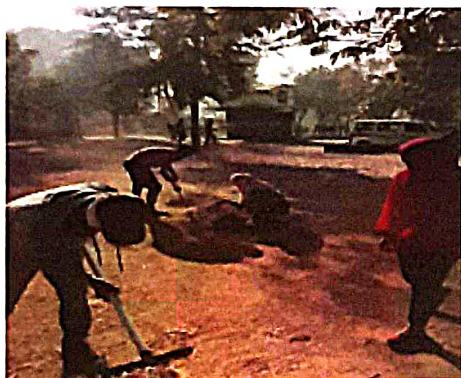
