

# CONSTITUTION & FUNCTIONALITY OF ADVISORY BOARD OF CONSTITUENT INSTITUTES/ CENTERS OF CHARUSAT

Each Constituent of CHARUSAT i.e. an Institute or a Center shall have an Advisory Board. The Advisory Board has been conceived with the objective of nurture and development of Constituents (Institute/ Center) of CHARUSAT. ## I. Constitution

1. Convener – to be appointed by the Sponsoring Body -Kelavani Mandal
2. Patron Donor of Institute or his Nominee (by virtue of the donation)
3. Two nominees of the Sponsoring Body - Kelavani Mandal for each department/ discipline/ specialization
4. Two members from among the “Donors” of CHARUSAT (to be nominated by the Sponsoring Body - Kelavani Mandal)
5. One expert from outside the Institute for each department of the Institute to be nominated by Provost in consultation with Principal / Head of Institute
6. Invitees, as and when necessary
7. Advisor(s), CHARUSAT as nominated by the Provost.
8. Head of Departments (Ex-officio)
9. Principal (Member Secretary; Ex-officio)

## II. Functionality

1. Monitoring activities of Institute/ Center and to suggest measures for the enriched functioning of the Institution/ Center
2. To suggest measures for enhanced industrial interaction, increased placements, alumni linkages, staff training and development and other such initiatives.
3. To suggest resource mobilization plans including financial and intellectual resources
4. To recommend measures for all-round development of the Institute/ Center

He familiarized the university, faculty and institute, its inception year and discussed on the initial intake and the current intake of the institute. ### **Agenda Proceedings & Resolutions:**

#### **Item 3.01: For Discussion and suggestions;**

To gather the suggestions for improving the academic activities

#### **Proceedings 3.01:**

- Mr. Umesh Shah and Dr. Y. P. Kosta suggested that academia and the industry need to work collaboratively in order to groom the students according to the current market requirements.
- Dr. Y.P. Kosta discussed that the students utilize very less time in their development. All the development activities should be arranged after their teaching-learning hours. They should be taught necessary fundamental courses, Core courses from the early semesters. It was discussed to ensure all required core courses are included in the curriculum from initial semesters.
- Mr. Umesh Shah suggested that the students should be taught for using IT as a tool to develop good life of society. He said that he will surely take the responsibility to train the students to develop the projects for the welfare of the society.
- Mr. Hemal Patel discussed that the courses should be divided into two categories namely Trending Generation and Next Generation. Unique courses (not in any state universities) should be introduced under these categories. The courses under the Next Generation will be short live until they become part of “trend technologies”. This needs to be separate page offering and we must mandate student to take two or three courses under this category.

- Mr. Maulik Bhansali discussed that the institute is appreciable for providing nice practical exposure to the students. He suggested this type of exposure should be from first year of their studies and the credits should be taken into consideration.
- He discussed that many opportunities may be introduced through start-ups and digitization.
- Activities under various Students' Club and Peer Learning sessions were appreciated by Ms. Saroj Gedia. She discussed that this type of the activities is the reason that the students are more interactive and innovative.

### **Resolutions 3.01:**

All Heads of Departments/Principal should take a note of the above resolution and do the needful.

### **Item 3.02: For Discussion and suggestion;**

To gather the suggestions for improving the Students' career and placement activities.

### **Proceedings 3.02:**

- Mr. Hemal Patel expressed his concern towards increasing trend for entrepreneurship.
- Dr. Amit Ganatra requested Mr. Hemal Patel to conduct counseling sessions to motivate students for entrepreneurship.
- Dr. Y.P. Kosta requested Mr. Hemal Patel for increasing the package offered to students from Sophos. He expressed his concern for students migrating abroad.
- He suggested that students should be counselled for retention in India for Higher Studies. In addition to this, Dr. Y. P. Kosta suggested that in India, hackathons should be promoted for the circulation of money.
- Dr. Y.P. Kosta suggested to celebrate days like English Day to enhance communication skills of the students. Mock reviews should be conduct on frequent basis. He added that CHARUSAT is soon to be the residential campus to promote the development of the students after their college hours.
- Mr. Maulik Bhansali suggested that orientation on the skill development of the students is important and should be done since their beginning of the university life.
- He further added that Students' internship should be evaluated more rigorously. He discussed that he will play a role in strong grooming of the students in terms of practical and industrial knowledge.

- Mr. Himanshu Thakkar suggested that the mindset of the students needs to be understood since their Day 1 in the institute. Attitude and aptitude sessions should be conducted from early years of their college days and multiple sessions need to be arranged with limited batch size.
- Mr. Himanshu Thakkar added that there should be some mechanism such that inhouse or external agencies should contact each of our students personally for improving all the required aspects in them. Communication skills can be improved in the students with the help of the faculty members.
- He further discussed that continuous counseling may help the students to divert towards serving their own country rather than migrating abroad.
- Mr. Rajesh Shah and Mr. Ronak Shah suggested training and placement activities should be focused in the next presentation. Moreover, earlier engagement of students (preferably from 7<sup>th</sup> semester) in industry during their studies is more important.
- Mr. Rinkesh Arora suggested to groom students for their career goals since initial days of their college studies.
- Mr. Abhijit Yard shared that students need to be motivated for being active sales executive. Students should be more techno-commercials.

### **Resolutions 3.02:**

Training and Placement Officer (TPO), Career Development and Placement Cell (CDPC)/Heads of Departments should take a note of the above resolution and do the needful.

### **Item 3.03: For Discussion and suggestion;**

To gather the suggestions for increasing Research activities.

### **Proceedings 3.03:**

- Interdisciplinary projects by students and faculty members should be enhanced.
- The project proposal submissions to funding agencies should be done in consultation with industry experts.
- The problem statements from the industry may be collected and given to the students to work on problems.
- Ms. Saroj Gedia and Mr. Umesh Shah appreciated DEPSTAR students for the start-up(s) initiated by DEPSTAR students in AY:2020-21. Ms. Saroj Gedia suggested that more mentors need to be invited for guiding the students in terms of start-up(s).
- Ms. Saroj Gedia discussed on collaborative work to be carried out amongst industry and academia and initiate student exchange programme to enhance cultural understanding.

- She further added that increase in number of industry visits in turn will help students to get innovative problem-solving ideas.
- Mr. Divyesh Sanghani appreciated the working attitude of faculty members. He suggested that there should be proper schedule and the protocol for the faculty members to balance work with life.
- Mr. Divyesh Sanghani added that research of the faculty members may get enhanced by following proper working methodology, schedule and protocol. Everything maintained on paper is important. Faculty training programme should be planned in order to familiarize them about industrial work environment.
- Mr. Hemal Patel discussed that lots of free corporate project gives us public visibility. For e.g. corporate video, process video, Marketing material co-branded with CHARUSAT logo.
- He added this will give an opportunity to our student to do different project every year so coping can be avoided. He took a responsibility to work for the collaborative project in the field of AR/VR and medical that can be proposed and worked on together in the future.
- Mr. Hemal Patel further suggested to initiate extra-curricular activities like adopting a village, setting-up a room and send our student to teach in that village.
- As per the suggestion of Mr. Hemal Patel we should set up small computer lab in rural schools by using our out of service computers and send our student for social service to teach them.
- As the special remark, Dr. M.C.Patel suggested to analyze what is lacking for development of student, faculty and the institute and to focus on finding the reason of the same to improve on it.
