Any dispute arising during execution of the project shall be settled amicably among the institutes. In case the issue is not resolved among the institutes, the Director General, NMCG shall be the arbitrator and decision of the DG, NMCG shall final and binding.

3.0 Project Specific Conditions

i)

- a) The necessary arrangements for implementation of the project shall be done by NEERI Nagpur and the associated institutes mentioned under point 2 (a).
- b) The work related to the project shall be carried out after ensuring the objective and the methodology followed as per standard procedures/ methodology, especially for the laboratory analytical works.
- c) While executing the project, the institutes shall focus on obtaining maximum information form the study by various means of interpretations and data mining.
- d) The institutes shall tie up, on their own, with the local department/ authorities regarding local facilities & assistances, if any.
- e) As per the proposal of NEERI, the study will be carried out on the entire Ganga River in stretches as per planning of NEERI. There will be total Seven stretches in the river viz. Origin to Haridwar, Haridwar to Narora, Narora to Kanpur, Kanpur to Pryagraj, Pryagraj to Varanasi, Varanasi to Rajmahal and Rajmahal to Diamond Harbor. Three samples shall be collected from each of the stretches in triplicate and at each sampling point, water, sediment and microbial mats will be collected. Also, the activity shall be carried out twice in two years and avoiding monscon period. Hence a total of 378 samples shall be collected and analyzed under the project, as per the proposal. However, NEERI may suitably rework the planning, with approval of Competent Authority ie NMCG, within overall sanctioned cost, as per the requirements.
- 15 GB of data shall be generated from each sample. Raw data generated and sequences obtained after sorting, shall be shared with NMCG for both (pre-Monsoon & Winter) the sample analysis.
- g) The reports etc. are to be furnished by NEERI as per approved milestones [Para 3(l)] and payment will be released only after approval of such reports by Competent Authority in NMCG.
- h) The project shall be executed as per the milestones specified under point 3 (1).

- i) Total project cost is Rs. 933.45 Lakh (Rs Nine Crore, Thirty-Three Lakhs and Forty-Five Thousand Only) against the following specific objectives:
 - Indicators of type of contamination (Sewage and Industrial)
 - Ecosystem services of the river (nutrient recycling, fisheries etc.)
 - Define health of the river/ rejuvenation efficiency
 - Threat to human health (antibiotic resistance surge)
 - Identification of the source of E. coli (Human v/s Animal)
- j) All the payments shall be released by NMCG to NEERI, Nagpur. The total funds will be divided amongst the five selected institutes as per detailed in table below. However, if required, Director NEERI (or authorized official) may review or rework inter-se distribution, with approval of NMCG.
