2. Measures taken to complete the syllabus of courses and programs.		There was a lockdown in the state in AY: 2020-2021 due to second wave of COVID-19. It has come with challenges in the teaching – learning process. Various online tools and Learning Management Systems including google classroom, google meet and Microsoft teams were utilized by the faculty members of the institute to create virtual classrooms to facilitate teaching-learning of the students, while they were at home. Through the experience; we had realized that the virtual classroom might not ensure the successful learning process, moreover the involvement from the studentswould also vital in the virtual environment. The faculty members participated in workshops and training programs to sharpen their skills in conducting courses through online modes with aim to enhance the involvement of students, in online teaching-learning process. They evolved approaches including, making animated videos, making pre-recorded video assignments, arrangement of interactiveexpert sessions to ensure participation of students. Many pre-recorded audio and video sessions are now available to the students to view as per their convenience and to learn at their own pace. The students were continuously evaluated through online quizzes and assignments using on-line platforms during the lock down period. The institute offered simultaneous off-line and on-line sessions as per the government guideline.
